Sleep in Heavenly Peace: We are kicking off our next Mission Project by volunteering for an organization called *Sleep in Heavenly Peace*. This is a group that makes beds for children in the Greater Rochester area who are sleeping on the floor. We are volunteering to build beds on **Saturday, September 9th**. The build will take place at the Macedon Lowes. You DO NOT need any construction experience to volunteer! You will sign up for a 2-hour time slot. A roll out of the online volunteer website will happen as it gets a little closer. Children under 12 must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times and minors 12 and older should be accompanied to the build by a legal guardian.

Also, we will be collecting donations of twin sized "bed in a bags" for children, tweens, and teens. You can also donate a blanket. Blankets can be homemade, but must be new. No pillows needed at this time! These items will be collected and displayed at the front of the church like we did for the Cameron cleaning supplies.
